The purpose of this letter is to request that Toronto Fashion Week, once again, be declared as an "Fent of Municipal Significance".

Toronto Fashion Week is the premier designer fashion industry event in Canada. Owned and operated by IMG Fashion since August 2012, the event was purchased by visionary developer Peter Freed of Freed Developments in December of 2016. The event will continue to provide a platform for both up and coming and established designer brands to reach critical media, buyers and the industry as a whole, both in Canada and around the world. The event will change from a five day event to three days and will move from David Pecaut Square to the Bloor Yorkville area which will become the epicenter of fashion in the city as all eyes turn to see the collections unveiled. The event will grow to include programming elements of fashion as the focus but will also include art, culture and entertainment components.

The event will be held in a tented environment. A street closure application for Yorkville Avenue and Hazelton Avenue has been submitted to the City of Toronto for review. It will commence Tuesday, Sept 5th and run through Thursday, Sept 7, 2017. The general hours of operation will be 11:00am to 11:00pm for the three days of the event.
