Our clients oppose this proposal for a number of reasons; which include:

- 1. This building setback initiative is premature and should await the outcome of the TOcore process. The policy framework for this area is under review and should be in place before any implementing zoning provisions are considered.
- 2. There is currently little uniformity of existing street setbacks within the area affected by the proposed rezoning. Imposing a uniform standard is inappropriate and fails to recognize/encourage the differences that presently exist and/or site specific circumstances which militate against the proposed setback standard.
