# Supplemental Report – Ontario's Action Plan for Seniors Includes a Focus on Long-Term Care

# **SUMMARY**

During Community Development and Recreation Committee's consideration of the report, Ontario's Action Plan for Seniors Includes a Focus on Long-Term Care, a request was made to provide Members of Council with a map showing the location of the 84 long-term care homes in Toronto, highlighting those operated by the City, and all of those requiring mandatory redevelopment.

### **COMMENTS**

In 2015 when preparing the Long-Term Care Homes & Services' Capital Renewal Plan, staff had a map created to show locations of the 84 long-term care homes operating within the City of Toronto, indicating those requiring mandatory redevelopment to meet new design standards. The map also included information about the percentage of individuals age 65 or older by ward as of 2015.

At that time, there were 6 City-operated homes requiring redevelopment. Since then, Kipling Acres, a 337 bed home within the Central West Local Health Integration Network (Ward 2) has been redeveloped. There are currently 5 City of Toronto directly-operated homes requiring redevelopment, shown as red squares, on the map, Appendix A:

Carefree Lodge	Central LHIN	Ward 24
Fudger House	Toronto Central LHIN	Ward 28
Lakeshore Lodge	Toronto Central LHIN	Ward 6
