Dear Art:

I am writing further to our previous discussions concerning the University of Toronto's proposed development of 698 Spadina Avenue, a building in which you are currently resident.

We understand that you presently use a coach house adjacent to your residence to carry out music performance and learning activities, and that this access will cease at such time as the proposed development commences construction. In the event the proposed development is approved by the Local Planning Appeal Tribunal, the University of Toronto, through its Faculty of Music, will provide you with a space to carry out these activities for a five-year period to commence one year following any such decision. We would be pleased to revisit and reassess the arrangement for possible renewal at the end of that period.

In the context of the Faculty of Music *Strategic Academic Plan 2016–2021*, there is value in the community-based music making and learning activities you lead that is consistent with our vision and the University's priorities for city engagement. Although space is always at a premium in the Faculty of Music (due to extensive program needs) and the exact location we would be able to provide is yet to be confirmed, we are confident that we can work with you to find appropriate space, either in the Edward Johnson Building (at 80 Queen's Park) or, more likely, in the Faculty of Music (south) building (at 90 Wellesley Street West). The space will provide basic furnishing (music chairs and table), music stands, and secure storage for musical scores and instruments, all of which the University of Toronto and the Faculty of Music will provide at no expense to you.
