Dear Mayor and Members of City Council,

The South Eglinton Ratepayers' and Residents' Association (SERRA), being a Yonge Street RA would like to request that you do not approve the Public Works and Infrastructure Committee recommendation and instead approve the staff recommendation to support *Transform Yonge*.

The *Transform Yonge* alternative would extend the Yonge Street vibrancy to downtown North York and honour Toronto's commitment to Vision Zero. It is supported by a majority of local residents.

With fatal collisions rising on Toronto streets, this is a perfect opportunity to transform North York downtown and this section of Yonge Street into a place where people of all ages and abilities can get around safely.
