Expanded Gaming at Woodbine Racetrack - City Conditions

SUMMARY

This placeholder report is to advise that the Interim City Manager will be bringing forward a report to the April 17, 2017 Executive Committee meeting.

On July 7, 2015, City Council passed a resolution supporting expanded gaming at Woodbine Racetrack subject to, among other things, Ontario Lottery & Gaming Corporation's service provider (now Ontario Gaming GTA LP) meeting 21 planning, economic, labour, social and health related conditions (EX7.4).

The purpose of the report is to provide an assessment on how Ontario Gaming GTA LP has met or has contractually committed to meeting the nine non-planning conditions. An assessment on the 12 planning conditions is included as a part of item EY29.2, *Final Report - 555 Rexdale Boulevard - Zoning By-law Amendment and Draft Plan of Subdivision Applications* which will be considered by Etobicoke-York Community Council on April 4, 2018:
