Re: <u>EX32.1 – City of Toronto Long-Term Financial Plan</u>

I would like to start by thanking the staff at the City of Toronto, under the leadership of outgoing City Manager Peter Wallace, for highlighting in this report the opportunities and challenges that lie ahead for Toronto. As the largest funder of community and social services outside of government, United Way Toronto and York Region works with our staff, volunteers, donors, agencies and partners in labour and government to not only meet the urgent and growing need in underserved communities, but to implement long term investments strategies that are driven towards success in fighting local poverty. And the City of Toronto is a key ally in that mission.

United Way and its agencies collaborate with several City divisions to help sustain adequate service levels across all neighbourhoods, while at the same time identify opportunities to work together on research, public policy and systemic solutions related to poverty reduction and improving access to the services and supports residents need. For example, we have aligned our respective youth employment strategies _ Career Navigator ™ and PAYE _ to better connect young people with training and employers; and developed synergies in our "Strong Neighbourhoods" strategies. Those collaborative efforts over the years have helped make our city more livable and vibrant. However, a real challenge lies ahead: making Toronto a city of opportunity for everyone.

That evidence is laid out in our recent research titled *The Opportunity Equation*. The reports show that growing concentration of poverty, declining job quality and rising income inequality, are creating an uneven playing field and compromising our fundamental principles of fairness, belonging and opportunities for success.
