Dear Mayor John Tory, and Members of the Executive Committee,

Flemingdon Community <u>Legal Services</u> strongly supports a legally-binding community benefits agreement for the Woodbine Casino Redevelopment Project.

We endorse the Toronto Community Benefits Networks (TCBN) proposals for a comprehensive agreement providing for training, good jobs, local procurement and other opportunities for North Etobicoke and similarly historically disadvantaged communities and equity seeking groups in Toronto, as well as a fair share of casino revenues to support ongoing community programs.

Three key areas have been identified for improvement with respect to the current proposals at the Woodbine Casino Redevelopment Project:

- Creating clear accountability, reporting, and oversight mechanisms so that the public can be assured that jobs and investment will benefit the local community and equity seeking groups;
- 2. Securing supports for the community, such as child care for the casino workers, which will be key to successful local hiring; and
- Strengthening the community and labour representation on the various oversight committees, in order to build strong relationships and community engagement that will sustain this agreement over the long term.
