






Coral Gables Country Club . Constructed 1924



Constructed in 1911, Casa Loma is one of North America's only full sized castles. Sir Henry Pellatt engaged noted architect E.J. Lennox to help him realize a lifelong dream, the creation of an Edwardian castle on the top of a hill overlooking Toronto. It took 300 men nearly three years to complete the nearly to 200,000 square foot castle at a cost \$3,500,000 (at the time). Situated on 5 acres, Casa Loma was the largest private residence in Canada.

In January 2014, the Liberty Entertainment Group entered into a long term lease of Toronto's Casa Loma. After an extensive RFP process, the City of Toronto approved the Liberty Group to take over the historic complex, which was completed in 1914. This includes all aspects of the operation of Casa Lomas as both a special event facility as well as an attraction. The Liberty Entertainment Group, under Nick Di Donato's direction, has undertaken to preserve and make improvements to the heritage facility.







The Ontario Government Building located in the western sector of Exhibition Place is a remarkable architectural landmark designated under the Ontario Heritage Act. Constructed in 1926, this two-story cast-stone structure with its triangular shape, featuring an enclosed colonnade surrounding an open courtyard, offers a distinct opportunity for the unique aesthetic approach of the Liberty Entertainment Group. 



The Coral Gables Country Club has an impressive heritage. Originally part of the 1921 city plan by George Merrick and landscape architect, Frank Button, the Country Club proudly became Coral Gables' first public building. This heritage site quickly turned into the epicentre of the new community and played an important role in its development.


After an extensive RFP process with the City of Coral Gables, the Liberty Entertainment Group took over the management of the Coral Gable Country Club in 2010, signing a 30-year lease to run the historic club. Originally constructed in 1924, the forty thousand square foot complex underwent extensive renovations and reopened to the public under the operation of Liberty Entertainment Group in November of 2010.
