Re: Administrative Inquiry on Traffic Control Warrants

Councillor Janet Davis submitted an Administrative Inquiry under Municipal Code S27-61 to seek information regarding previous direction by Council for Transportation Services to review current warrants for traffic controls and provide recommendations for changes to enhance safety, and to determine an updated timeline for reporting.

1. Has the General Manager, Transportation Services reviewed the current warrants for traffic control measures and drafted a report to be submitted to the Public Works and Infrastructure Committee with recommendations for changes to enhance safety?

Transportation Services has been working to review existing traffic control warrants to identify recommendations to improve road safety of our most vulnerable road users including pedestrians and cyclists and to ensure that current City warrants are consistent with best practice and the latest provincial guidance, where applicable.

A forthcoming report is being drafted and will include recommendations on specific changes to existing traffic control warrants.

2. What is the updated timeline to receive that report since the original deadline of Q1 of 2017 has now passed?

The report is scheduled to be submitted to the May 18, 2018 Public Works and Infrastructure Committee.
