BY-LAW No.

To extend the hours of sale of liquor by holders of a licence under the Liquor Licence Act by two hours in the morning during the FIFA World Cup 2018.

WHEREAS under subsection 62.1(1) of the *Liquor Licence Act*, the City may pass by-laws extending the hours of sale of liquor in all or part of the City by the holders of a licence and a by-law may authorize a specified officer or employee of the City to extend the hours of sale during events of municipal, provincial, national or international significance; and

WHEREAS under subsection 62.1(3) of the *Liquor Licence Act*, this by-law does not prevail over a condition that is imposed by the Registrar of Alcohol and Gaming under subsection 8(3), 14(1) or 17(5), or a condition that is imposed under subsection 9(6) or by the Board under subsection 12(2), 17(7) or 23(11) or (12) or a condition that is consented to by an applicant or licensee under subsection 12(2) or 17(7); and

WHEREAS the FIFA World Cup will be held in Russia on June 14 to July 15, 2018 with events starting at 9:00 a.m.;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. In the City of Toronto during the period of June 14 to July 15, 2018, both inclusive, liquor may be sold by the holders of a licence under the *Liquor Licence Act* beginning at 9:00 a.m.
