137 Dunvegan Road - Request for Attendance at a Toronto Local Appeals Body Hearing - Appeal of Committee of Adjustment Decision by Councillor Josh Matlow, seconded by Councillor Kristyn Wong-Tam

#### Recommendations

Councillor Josh Matlow, seconded by Councillor Kristyn Wong-Tam, recommends that:

1. City Council authorize the City Solicitor, along with appropriate City Staff, to attend the Toronto Local Appeal Body and to retain outside consultants, as necessary, in order to oppose the variances requested in Application A0544/17TEY respecting 137 Dunvegan Road.

2. City Council authorize the City Solicitor to attempt to negotiate with the applicant a resolution of the City's concerns in consultation with the Ward Councillor and appropriate City Staff.

3. In the event that a resolution is not reached, City Council authorize the City Solicitor, along with appropriate City Staff and outside consultants, as necessary, to attend the Toronto Local Appeal Body in order to oppose the variances requested in Application A0544/17TEY respecting 137 Dunvegan Road.

#### Summary

An application for variances with respect to the property known as 137 Dunvegan Road was heard by the Committee of Adjustment Toronto and East York Panel on March 28, 2018 proposing to construct a new three-storey detached dwelling with a rear integral three-car garage with a second floor terrance above (the "Application"). The Applicantion is known as municipal file number A0544/17TEY.

The Committee approved the Application on condition.

This Motion will give the City Solicitor, along with appropriate City staff, authority to attend the Toronto Local Appeal Body and to retain outside consultants, as necessary, in order to oppose the Application and the requested variances. This Motion will also give the City Solicitor, in consultation with the Ward Councillor and appropriate City Staff, authority to attempt to negotiate with the applicant a resolution of the City's concerns. In the event that a resolution is not reached, this Motion authorizes the City Solicitor, and appropriate City Staff and outside consultants, to attend the Toronto Local Appeal Body in order to oppose the Application and the requested variances.

The Toronto Local Appeal Body hearing is scheduled for September 5, 2018.
