Notice of Motion - MM43.9

The 2018 Approved Capital Budget for Parks, Forestry and Recreation includes \$70,000 for the Magwood Park Fitness Stations project and \$418,000 for the Ravina Gardens Wading Pool Conversions project.

The 2018-2027 Capital Budget and Plan for Parks, Forestry and Recreation will increase by \$129,000 gross, \$0 debt, with cash flows of \$100,000 in 2018 and \$29,000 in 2019, fully funded by Section 42 Alternate Rate Cash-in-Lieu. Funds will be used to increase total project costs to \$559,000 for the Ravina Gardens Wading Pool Conversion project.

The 2018 Capital Budget for Parks, Forestry and Recreation will decrease by \$70,000 gross, reducing the total project cost of the Magwood Park Fitness Station project and releasing commitments on the associated Section 42 funding sources. The project has been cancelled as the park is archaeologically sensitive and is not an appropriate site to install fitness stations.



The total impact to the 2018-2027 Capital Budget and Plan is an increase in project costs of \$59,00	0, with
increased cash flow of \$30,000 in 2018 and \$29,000 in 2019.	

Funds have been received and are being used for their intended purposes.
