Notice of Motion – MM43.39				
Amend the 2018 Capital Budget for Toronto Employment and Social Services by increasing the project cost of Wellesley Place Employment and Social Service Office project (CSS903-01) by \$800,000 gross, \$0 debt, to address unforeseen building conditions. The funding will be provided by a draw of \$400,000 from the Social Assistance Stabilization reserve (XQ1054) and by permanently reallocating funding of \$400,000 from 2 existing capital projects included in the 2018-2027 Council Approved Capital Budget and Plan for Facilities Management, Real Estate Services, and Environment and Energy Division.				
Approved project costs in FREEE that will be reallocated include Mechanical and Electrical Systems project (CCA247-33) and \$15 project (CCA242-01).				
Funds will be used to amend Purchase Order 6045764 issued to Rossclair Contractors Inc. by \$800,000				

to \$8,269,859 excluding taxes, associated with the Wellesley Place Employment and Social Service



The budget adjustment is time sensitive and urgent as the Ontario Disability Support Program, wh	nich
serves a caseload of 11,000, must move into the building at the end of July.
