Recommendations

Councillor Michelle Holland, seconded by Councillor Michael Thompson, recommends that:

1. City Council direct the Chief Planner and Executive Director, City Planning to retain the boundaries of the Golden Mile Secondary Plan Review Study as approved in Items beginning in January of 2018 and that no alterations be permitted without direction and approval from Scarborough Community Council.

Summary

The Golden Mile Secondary Plan Review Study is intended to develop a vision and planning framework for the Golden Mile area in advance of the opening of the Eglinton Crosstown Light Rail Transit line. City Planning staff, Councillors, residents, business owners and interested stakeholders have been participating in the study through meetings and submissions over the past year. Those participating have worked with City staff based on the boundaries of the Study as enunciated in Items on the matter. The Study is bounded by Victoria Park Avenue to the west, Ashtonbee Road/Hydro Corridor to the north, Birchmount Road to the east, and an irregular boundary to the south. The study area is approximately 97 hectares (240 acres) in size.
