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The cost to install traffic control signals and to remove a pedestrian crossover cannot be fully determined at this time, however, it can be accommodated within the existing 2018 Capital Budget for Transportation Services.

The removal of three on-street parking spaces on Queen Street E. would result in an annual revenue loss of approximately \$14,539 for Toronto Parking Authority. This results in a prorated revenue loss of approximately \$6,058 in 2018. There are no paid parking options on Lockwood Road.
