Subject: Honouring Former Councillor Ron Moeser

Mayor Tory and Members of Council,

Further to the direction provided by Mayor Tory to convene a panel of community members to receive feedback on how to honour former Councillor Ron Moeser, and further to the Ward consultation meeting chaired by Councillor Hart on April 23, 2018, this letter is being sent to confirm that the West Rouge Community Association supports honouring the legacy of Mr. Moeser through the naming of a portion of the Waterfront Trail, from Highland Creek eastwards to the entrance to Rouge National Urban Park in Mr. Moeser's name.

The West Rouge Community Association represents approximately 3,000 households in Ward 44 (to become Ward 47) from Port Union Road to Rouge National Urban Park, and from Lake Ontario to Highway 401.

Mr. Moeser's impact on our Ward was, and is, significant and meaningful. He was a strong voice for eastern Scarborough for 26 years, and his contribution to our community, including the establishment of the Waterfront Trail deserves lasting recognition. We are proud of Mr. Moeser and request the City's assistance in honouring him in an appropriate manner.
