PROPOSAL

This City-initiated request to modify Official Plan Amendment No. 231, Site and Area Specific Policy 426 (SASP 426) (which is currently not in force), proposes to modernize the language of the SASP to reflect the 2017 Growth Plan's policies regarding the amenitization of office areas; clarify the subject lands affected by the employment use permissions and requirements; and permit additional non-residential land uses that will serve and amenitize employment uses within the subject lands.

The subject lands are also subject to applications under the *Planning Act* for amendments to zoning by-laws, official plan amendment, and approval of plan of subdivision: Application Nos. 16 270071 STE 30 OZ, 15 236783 STE 30 OZ, and 16 270078 STE 30 SB.
