PROPOSAL - PURPOSE AND EFFECT

The Second Units Official Plan Amendment seeks to clarify the existing Official Plan second unit permissions across the entire City of Toronto. The amendment would strengthen the existing Official Plan policies that provide for a full range of housing and intensification and infill that is consistent with the Official Plan. The amendment is also a response to provincial policy and legislative changes in 2016 for official plans to contain specific polices relating to second units.

This Official Plan Amendment will be in conformity with the Growth Plan for the Greater Golden Horseshoe, 2017 (Growth Plan) and will be submitted to the Minister of Municipal Affairs and Housing for approval pursuant to Section 26 of the Planning Act.

The Official Plan Amendment proposes to amend Section 3.2.1 (Housing) of the Toronto Official Plan. A proposed policy would clarify second unit permissions city-wide. A new sidebar adjacent to the new policy would also be added to provide supporting information.

The Planning Act requires that a Special Public Meeting must be held on any proposed amendments to the Official Plan and that an Open House be held if the Official Plan is being amended to ensure that the public has an opportunity to review and ask questions about the information and material made available in advance of the Special Public Meeting. The holding of public hearings on the Official Plan amendment may be delegated by Council to the Planning and Growth Management Committee under Section 24 of the City of Toronto Act and the Toronto Municipal Code.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

Planning and Growth Management Committee, at their meeting of April 5, 2018, adopted a staff report on a Draft Official Plan Amendment for second units. At that meeting the Committee directed staff to use the proposed Policy for Second Units as a basis for public consultation and prepare a Final Recommendations Report with a proposed Official Plan Amendment for second units in the second quarter of 2018.
