

Temporary Adjustments to Parking Regulations for 2018 Canadian National Exhibition - Delegated

SUMMARY

This staff report concerns a matter for which the Community Council has delegated authority from City Council to make a final decision. The temporary parking amendments recommended are required to enhance traffic operations and pedestrian safety during this year's Canadian National Exhibition (CNE), which takes place from August 17 to September 3, 2018, inclusive.

RECOMMENDATIONS

The Acting Director, Transportation Services Division, Toronto and East York District, recommends that:

1. Toronto and East York Community Council authorize the temporary parking regulations on streets in the vicinity of Exhibition Place that are impacted during the Canadian National Exhibition, identified in Appendix "A" attached to the report dated June 8, 2018, from the Acting Director, Transportation Services, Toronto and East York District.

FINANCIAL IMPACT

Funds in the amount of \$3,000.00 are available within the Transportation Services Division's 2018 Operating Budget.

DECISION HISTORY

Annually, the Transportation Services Division receives Community and City Council authority to implement a number of temporary traffic and parking regulations on various streets in the vicinity of Exhibition Place that are impacted by the CNE.

COMMENTS

Having regard for the high volume of vehicular and pedestrian traffic generated during this annual event, the temporary parking regulations as shown in the attached Appendix "A" will help maintain efficient traffic conditions in the general area of the CNE while recognizing the impacts on local residents. None of the streets listed in Appendix "A" have regular TTC routes. It is noted that a companion report is also submitted relating to temporary traffic and parking adjustments for the 2018 CNE for streets served by transit routes and requiring City Council approval.

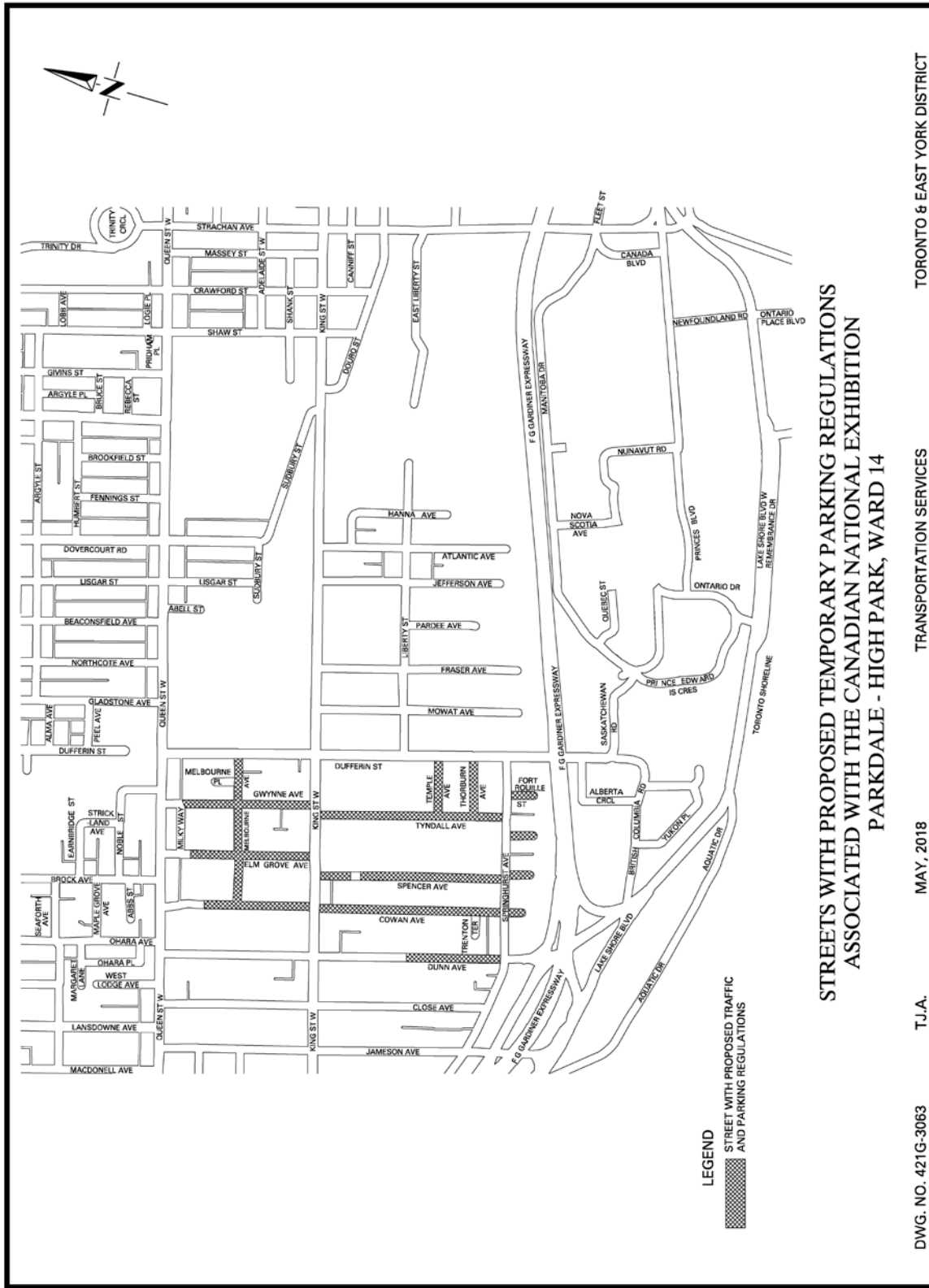
