Realignment of Permit Parking Area 3G to exclude the development located at 1025 Dupont Street

SUMMARY

Transportation Services is requesting approval from City Council to prohibit the General Manager from accepting applications from residents of, visitors to, and tradespersons at the development properties municipally known as 1025 Dupont Street for residential onstreet permit parking.

Transportation Services has assessed the realignment of permit parking area 3G and the exclusion of the development property located at 1025 Dupont Street as requested by Toronto and East York Community Council, Item TE33.107, on June 6, 2018. Transportation Services is recommending approval of the exclusion as it will not impact negatively on Dupont Street residents.

RECOMMENDATIONS

The Manager, Transportation Services, Right of Way Management, Toronto and East York District recommends that:

1. City Council approve the amendment to Schedule B of the City of Toronto Municipal Code, Chapter 925, Permit Parking, to incorporate a revised map of permit parking area "3G", as attached in Appendix A of the report dated June 12, 2018 from the Manager, Right of Way Management, Transportation Services, Toronto and East York District.

FINANCIAL IMPACT

There is no financial impact associated with this report.

DECISION HISTORY

At its meeting June 6, 2018 Toronto and East York Community Council in considering item TE33.107, requested Transportation Services to examine and report back to Toronto and East York Community Council regarding the realignment of permit parking area 3G and the exclusion of the development addresses of 1025 Dupont Street.

COMMENTS

Permit Parking area 3G is bounded on the west by Dufferin Street, on the north by the property lines of Dupont Street, on the east by Ossington Avenue and the south by the north end of Bloor Street West. Area 3G has 1,075 on-street parking spaces. To date, 782 permits have been issued. This area does not have a history of being waitlisted, meaning the demand for overnight on-street parking permits has never exceeded the supply of parking spaces. There is TTC service on Dupont Street. Councillor Ana Bailao and residents neighbouring 1025 Dupont Street support this action as a means of ensuring that this new development does not negatively impact the permit parking supply to the existing neighbourhood.

A Public Notice was placed on the City's website requesting those objecting to the exclusion of 1025 Dupont Street, from permit parking in area 3G to forward their objections in writing to the City Clerk, so they may be scheduled as deputations at the Toronto and East York Community Council meeting. The Clerk has confirmed that no objections have been received.

Transportation Services has no objections to the exclusion of 1025 Dupont Street from permit parking in area 3G.
