I am writing to request that our matter be put before the next City council meeting on February 21, 2018 to request a letter of Non-Objection letter for an extension of our liquor licence. Similar to last year, we would like to celebrate Canada day and one of our restaurants, being Loose Moose Tap & Grill, located at 146 Front Street West, Toronto, are wishing to apply for a temporary extension of their liquor licence to the area beside the restaurant to have Canada Day celebrations.

Date – Saturday, June 30, 2018 **to and including** Monday, July 2, 2018 for set up and take down and with the day of festivities on Sunday, July 1, 2018

Time - 9:00 a.m. Saturday to and including up to 6:00 p.m. Monday

Exact Location – outside alleyway area adjacent to existing licensed restaurant, Loose Moose Tap & Grill, 146 Front Street West, Toronto, on the west side of restaurant. See drawing of area attached. Dimensions of area are approximately 250 ft by 25 ft.

Both Food and Alcohol Service will be offered at various stations

I have attached a copy of the proposed alleyway area and the anticipated set up of the food and beverage stations. I can advise that a similar event was approved and held for Canada Day's 150th birthday last summer (a copy of your approval is attached). The AGCO approved the area for a capacity of 520. We did make washrooms available.

As such, I would ask that you place this matter on your agenda for your next council meeting in February and consider our request for a letter of non-objection for this purpose.
