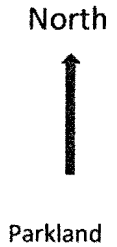
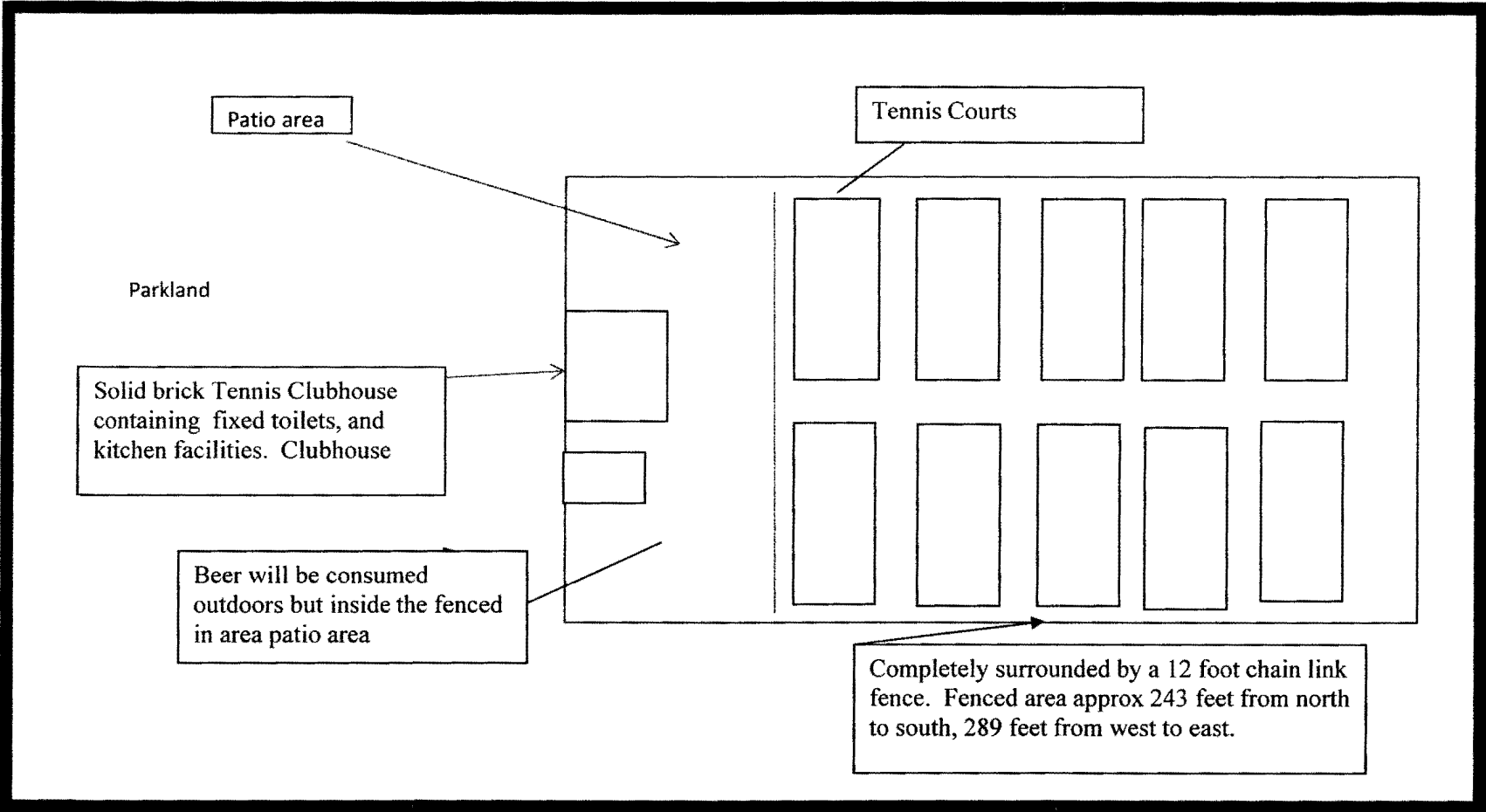
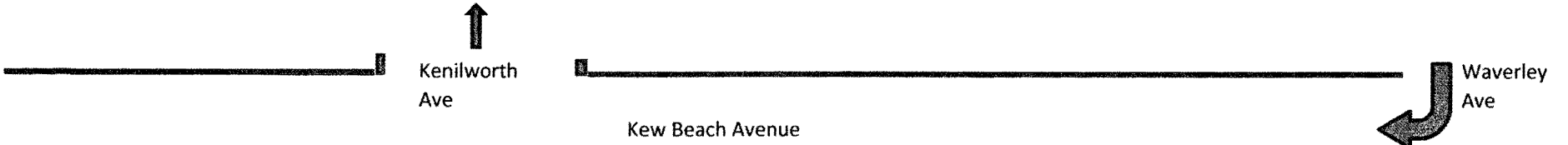
The events are not accessible to the public and will be behind 12 foot frost fencing and the gate will be closed.
