We are applying for a **Sale License** in order to serve beer, wine, and prosecco to our gallery patrons and visitors. The exhibition will feature the work of Toronto artist and educator Sara Angelucci, as she explores Hamilton's Copley Apparel factory and the many stories of the immigrant workers there.
