Please consider this letter as a formal request to have **Toronto Oktoberfest**, which will take place under a Festhalle-style tent in the Ontario Place Parking Lot, recognized as an event of municipal significance.

2018 will mark the seventh year of **Toronto Oktoberfest** – Toronto's first authentic Bavarian Celebration – an event the organizers have seen become an anticipated autumn tradition for the City of Toronto.

The organization producing the event is comprised of two partners, one of which is responsible for the successful Toronto Christmas Market, launched in 2010 at Toronto's Distillery Historic District, which now attracts over 600,000 visitors each year. The festival has also been supported by Celebrate Ontario over the years and will be again in 2018.

Inspired by the original Oktoberfest in Munich, Germany, **Toronto Oktoberfest** will once again capture the essence of Bavarian festivities through authentic food, drink and merriment and create a truly captivating experience, complete with Bavarian dancers, polka bands, authentic homemade fare, interactive contests and so much more. Recently, the event added an outdoor Bavarian Village complete with genuine Bavarian-themed games, rides, a German Porsche car show, and an all ages family session on Saturday during the day very similar to the traditional Munich celebration.

The mandate is to make **Toronto Oktoberfest** as authentic to the event's Bavarian origin as possible. Our goal is to create a cultural event for the City of Toronto that rivals the Kitchener-Waterloo festival.

The audience demographic is quite wide – our goal is to attract people of all ages to the event from within Toronto and surrounding cities.
