FINANCIAL IMPACT

The total contract award identified in this report is \$4,077,766 including all applicable taxes and charges. The cost to the City is \$3,672,154 net of HST recoveries.

Funding is available in the 2019 Approved Capital Budget and the 2020-2028 Approved Capital Plan for Toronto Water. The cash flow funding requirement for this project is shown in Table 1.

COMMENTS

This assignment will be carried out in three phases with the issuance of three (3) purchase orders and executed by three (3) engineering agreements as follows:

- a. Pre-Design and Detailed Design:
 - \$1,550,283.75 net of all applicable taxes and charges
 - \$1,751,820.64 including all applicable taxes and charges
 - \$1,577,568.74 net of HST recoveries
- b. Services During Construction:
 - \$1,914,251.95 net of all applicable taxes and charges
 - \$2,163,104.70 including all applicable taxes and charges
 - \$1,947,942.78 net of HST recoveries including
- c. Post-Construction Services:
 - \$144,107.00 net of all applicable taxes and charges
 - \$162,840.92 including all applicable taxes and charges
 - \$146,643.28 net of HST recoveries

For the recommended contract award, the following requirements have been met:

- a. The firm recommended for award is the highest scoring proponent based on the evaluation criteria included in the call and meeting the requirements of the call;
- b. The appropriate Division has reviewed submissions and found the price to be reasonable, within available budget and concurs with the recommendation;
- c. The total contract value is less than \$20 million dollars (excluding applicable taxes) and the contract term is:
 - 1. For a contract funded by the operating budget, 5 years or less including any option years; or
 - 2. For a contract funded by the capital budget, within the projected term of the capital funding for the project as set out in the capital budget,

Being within the authority of the Bid Award Panel;

- d. There are no material written objections to the award;
- e. The call document was advertised on the City's internet website and proposals were opened publicly; and
- f. The Fair Wage Office confirms the recommended firm understands the Fair Wage Policy and Labour Trades requirements and has agreed to comply fully.
