For minor bridge repairs, bridge deck flushing, chipping loose concrete from bridges and retaining wall repairs at various locations within the City of Toronto, Etobicoke York District.

\$1,015,462 net of all applicable taxes and charges
\$1,147,472 including HST and all applicable charges
\$1,033,334 net of HST recoveries

Contract is expected to start on May 14, 2019 and end on September 7, 2019.

FINANCIAL IMPACT

The total contract award identified in this report is \$1,147,472 including all applicable taxes and charges. The cost to the City is **\$1,033,334** net of HST recoveries.
