Description:

To rehabilitate three sanitary trunk sewers, namely, Mendota Sanitary Trunk Sewer from MH323-065-1 to MH323-074-1, Queensway Sanitary Trunk Sewer from MH321-020-1 to MH321-018-1 and Long Branch Sanitary Trunk Sewer from MH520-023-1 to MH520-031-1.

Recommended Bidder:

Capital Sewer Services Inc.

Contract Award Value:

\$14,829,888 net of all applicable taxes and charges
\$16,757,773 including HST and all applicable charges
\$15,090,894 net of HST recoveries

Contract is expected to start on the date of award and end in March 2022.

FINANCIAL IMPACT

The total contract award identified in this report is \$16,757,773 including all applicable taxes and charges. The cost to the City is \$15,090,894 net of HST recoveries.

Funding is available in the 2019 Approved Capital Budget and 2020-2028 Approved Capital Plan for Toronto Water. Funding details are summarized in Table 1 as follows:
