Re: Campaign Contribution of Judy Mathew

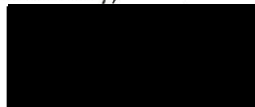
I am writing to apologize for the mistake in the campaign contribution amount made by Judy Mathew and her husband, Arun Thomas.

Last year when I was campaigning, I had asked Judy and Arun to make a contribution. I received in response a cheque for \$1240.00. I assumed, because of the amount, that it was a cheque from just Judy as she was the one who handed it to me. I thought that they had looked at the campaign limit and decided to only contribute for one of them. I did not realize when Judy handed me the cheque that the amount of \$1240 would be over the maximum amount of \$1200.

It was never my intention to try to get more from any one contributor than the maximum amount allowed under the campaign laws. Taking the cheque for \$1240 and marking the contribution down as being from Judy only was an oversight. If I had realized when I got the cheque that it was \$40 over the maximum limit, I would have asked Judy about it and then realized it was being made by both her and her husband. It is only that the amount over the limit was so low (i.e. \$40) that made me not think anything of the error.

Again, I apologize for the error, and for the inconvenience resulting from it.
