

### Appendix A – Recommended 2019 Solid Waste Management Services Rates and Fees

This Appendix provides details about the Public Notice hereby given. City of Toronto officials recommend that the City Council of the City of Toronto pass a By-law to increase current Solid Waste Management Services Rates and Fees, <u>all effective</u> retroactively to January 1, 2019.

As stated in the Public Notice, City of Toronto officials are recommending a blended 2.2% increase to the current Solid Waste Management Services Rates and Fees set forth in Schedule 1 of Appendix A to Chapter 441 of the Toronto Municipal Code (the "Schedule"). This includes a 1.0% rate increase to Multi-Residential Front End Container and Multi-Residential Curbside collection services, a 2.0% increase to Single Family Residential and Residential Units Above Commercial properties, and a 5.2% increase to most other Solid Waste Management Services Rates and Fees. Below are examples of several key Solid Waste Rates and Fees from the Schedule.

### 1. Multi-Residential Front End Solid Waste Management Services Rates proposed to increase by 1.0%
