Committee Recommendations

The Toronto Accessibility Advisory Committee recommends that:

1. The Executive Director, People, Equity and Human Rights be requested to provide the Toronto Accessibility Advisory Committee with an update on:
 - a. Item 2018.EX36.41 Persons with Disabilities Employment Strategy - Toronto Accessibility Advisory Committee Working Groups Update considered by the Executive Committee on July 17, 2018, requesting the development of a Persons with Disabilities Employment Strategy with the purpose of ensuring that persons with disabilities are employed at the City of Toronto at a level reflective of their representation in the population of the City;
 - b. 2018.EX30.28 Employment Accessibility at the City of Toronto;
 - c. the current representation rates of employees who self-disclose as having a disability within the City of Toronto workforce; and
 - d. what the City is doing to better allow for self-disclosure by employees who have a disability.
