

Introduction of Overnight On-Street Permit Parking – Cannes Circle

SUMMARY

This staff report is about a matter which Community Council has delegated authority from City Council to make a final decision.

Transportation Services is requesting approval from Etobicoke York Community Council to introduce overnight on-street permit parking on Cannes Circle, between the north leg of Symes Road and the south leg of Symes Road, on a street specific basis, under the operating hours of 12:01 a.m. to 7:00 a.m., seven days a week.

Area residents requested the implementation of overnight on-street permit parking on Cannes Circle, between the north leg of Symes Road and the south leg of Symes Road to accommodate their long term parking needs without being subject to tagging by Parking Enforcement Officers.

RECOMMENDATIONS

The Manager, Transportation Services, Right of Way Management, Toronto and East York District recommends that:

1. Etobicoke York Community Council Approve the amendment of Schedule A of City of Toronto Municipal Code, Chapter 925, Permit Parking, to incorporate both sides of Cannes Circle, between the north leg of Symes Road and the south leg of Symes Road, on a street specific basis, under the operating hours of 12:01 a.m. to 7:00 a.m., seven days a week.

FINANCIAL IMPACT

The amount of \$400.00 is available within the Transportation Services 2019 Operating Budget.

DECISION HISTORY

A request was received from Councillor Frances Nunziata, on behalf of area residents, to introduce the overnight on-street permit parking program on Cannes Circle, to accommodate their long term parking needs.

COMMENTS

Cannes Circle, between the north leg of Symes Road and the south leg of Symes Road, is a local roadway operating in a one-way westbound/northbound direction with a pavement width of 7.4 metres. There is no TTC service on Cannes Circle.

Parking is permitted for a maximum 3-hour duration on the southern east/west leg and western north/south leg sides of the street respectively.

Parking is prohibited on all other sections of the street.

Under the provisions of Municipal Code, Chapter 925, Permit Parking, a poll must be conducted to determine if there is support to introduce permit parking.

Ballots were mailed on September 20, 2018, with the last day for filing a response being October 19, 2018. The results of the poll are as follows:

The majority of area residents returned their ballots in favour of introducing overnight on-street permit parking on Cannes Circle, between the north leg of Symes Road and the south leg of Symes Road.

Transportation Services has no objections to the implementation of permit parking on Cannes Circle, between the north leg of Symes Road and the south leg of Symes Road.
