

Introduction of Overnight On-Street Permit Parking – Carnation Avenue

SUMMARY

This staff report is about a matter which Community Council has delegated authority from City Council to make a final decision.

Transportation Services is requesting approval from Etobicoke York Community Council to introduce overnight on-street permit parking on Carnation Avenue, between Twenty Fourth Street and Twenty Sixth Street, on a street name basis, under the operating hours of 12:01 a.m. to 7:00 a.m., seven days a week.

Area residents requested the implementation of overnight on-street permit parking on Carnation Avenue, between Twenty Fourth Street and Twenty Sixth Street to accommodate their long term parking needs without being subject to tagging by Parking Enforcement Officers.

RECOMMENDATIONS

The Manager, Transportation Services, Right of Way Management, Toronto and East York District recommends that:

1. Etobicoke York Community Council approve the amendment of Schedule A of City of Toronto Municipal Code, Chapter 925, Permit Parking, to incorporate the north side of Carnation Avenue, between Twenty Fourth Street and Twenty Sixth Street, on a street name basis, under the operating hours of 12:01 a.m. to 7:00 a.m., seven days a week.

FINANCIAL IMPACT

The amount of \$400.00 is available within the Transportation Services 2019 Interim Operating Budget.

DECISION HISTORY

A request was received from Councillor Mark Grimes, on behalf of area residents, to introduce the overnight on-street permit parking program on Carnation Avenue, to accommodate their long term parking needs.

COMMENTS

Carnation Avenue, between Twenty Fourth Street and Twenty Sixth Street, is a local roadway operating in a two-way east/westbound direction with a pavement width of 8 metres. There is no TTC service on Carnation Avenue.

Parking is permitted for a maximum 3-hour duration on the north sides of the street. Parking is prohibited on the south side at all times.

Under the provisions of Municipal Code, Chapter 925, Permit Parking, we are required to conduct a poll of the residents to determine if there is support to introduce permit parking.

Ballots were mailed on December 5, 2018, with the last day for filing a response being January 3, 2019. The results of the poll are as follows:

The majority of area residents returned their ballots in favour of the introduction of overnight on-street permit parking on Carnation Avenue, between Twenty Fourth Street and Twenty Sixth Street.

Transportation Services has no objections to the implementation of permit parking on Carnation Avenue, between Twenty Fourth Street and Twenty Sixth Street.
