

Rutherford Avenue and Victoria Boulevard from a "Street Specific" to a "Area based" Permit Parking program, within the newly created "15A" permit area

SUMMARY

This staff report is about a matter which Community Council has delegated authority from City Council to make a final decision.

Transportation Services is requesting approval from Etobicoke York Community Council to convert Rutherford Avenue and Victoria Boulevard from a "Street Specific" to a "Area based" Permit Parking program, within the newly created "15A" permit area.

Transportation Services recommends approval of this proposal as it will allow greater parking flexibility for residents.

RECOMMENDATIONS

The Manager, Transportation Services, Right of Way Management, Toronto and East York District recommends that:

1. Etobicoke York Community Council approve the amendment to Schedule 'B' of City of Toronto Municipal Code, Chapter 925, Permit Parking, to incorporate a new permit parking area "15A", as attached in Appendix "A" of the report, dated December 13, 2018, entitled "Conversion of Rutherford Avenue, between Weston Road and Nickle Street and Victoria Boulevard, between Weston Road and Nickle Street from "Street Name" to "Area Based" Permit Parking and creation of Permit Parking Area "15A".

FINANCIAL IMPACT

The amount of \$400.00 is available within the current interim Transportation Services 2019 Operating Budget

DECISION HISTORY

A request was received from Councillor Frances Nunziata, on behalf of area residents, to convert Rutherford Avenue and Victoria Boulevard from a "Street Specific" to a "Area Based" Permit Parking program and the creation of Permit Parking Area "15A" (Attachment A).

By allowing permit holders the ability to park on neighbouring streets, residents would gain greater parking flexibility.

COMMENTS

Rutherford Avenue is a local street operating in a two-way east/westbound direction, with a pavement width of 7.0 metres. There is no TTC Service on Rutherford Avenue. Permit Parking is in effect between the hours of 12:00 midnight to 6:00 a.m., 7 days a week. Parking alternates every two weeks from April 1st to December 1st. Parking is assigned to the north side from December 1st to April 1st of the following year.

Victoria Boulevard is a local street operating in a two-way east/westbound direction, with a pavement width of 7.3 metres. There is no TTC Service on Victoria Boulevard. Permit Parking is in place on the north side of the street and is operational from 12:00 midnight to 6:00 a.m., 7 days a week. Parking is prohibited at all times on the north side of the street.

The grouping of these streets within the boundary of the proposed permit parking area "15A" would allow for the consolidation of the existing 52 on-street parking spaces and would be available to all of the 23 existing permit holders within the area. This proposal will also allow residents of Weston Road, between Rutherford Avenue and Victoria Boulevard, as well as Nickle Street, between Rutherford Avenue and Victoria Boulevard, to be eligible for permits.

Transportation Services has no objections to the conversion of Rutherford Avenue and Victoria Boulevard from the "Street Name" to "Area Based" Permit Parking Program and creation of Permit Parking Area "15A".

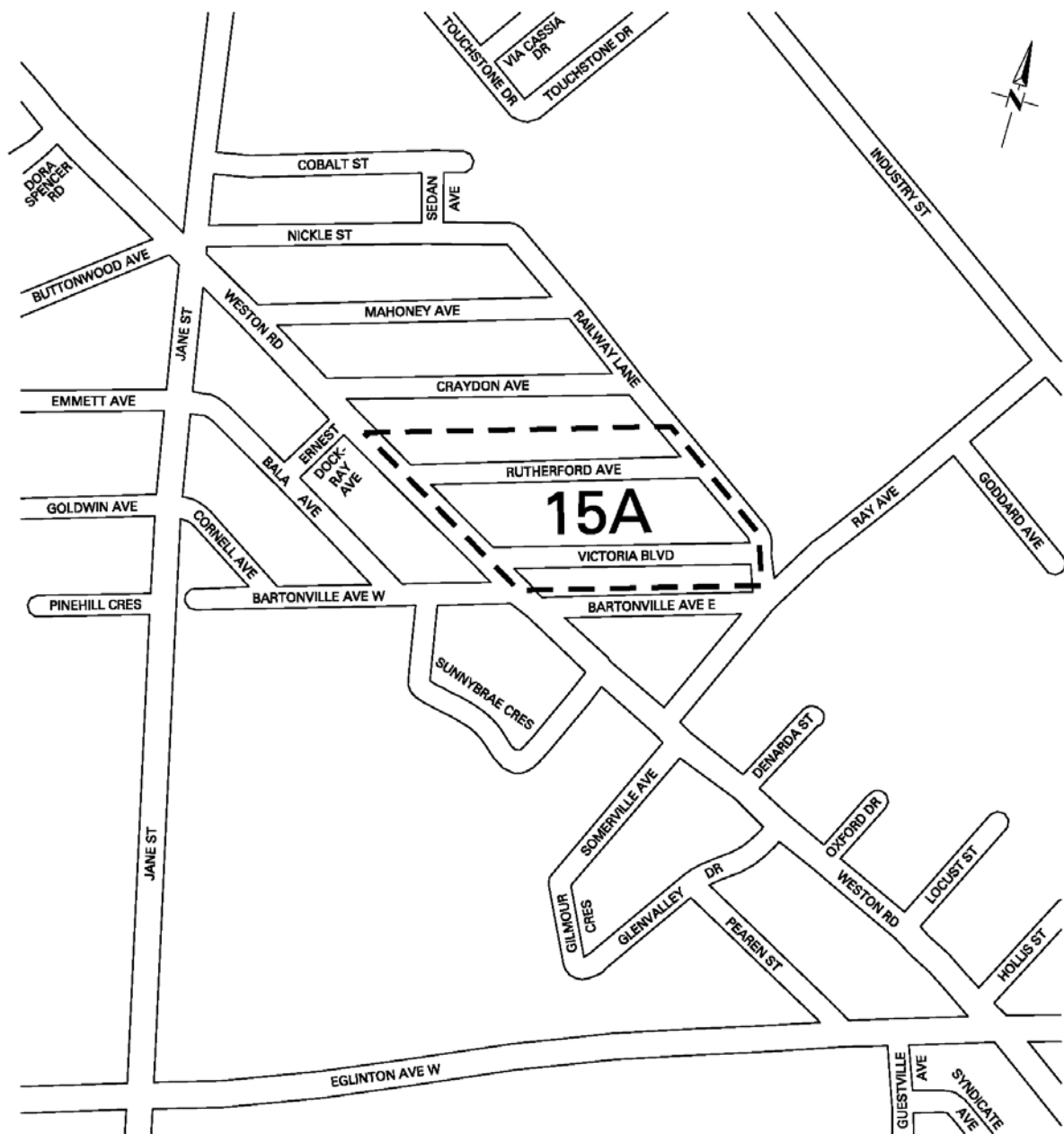
