

Introduction of Overnight On-Street Permit Parking – Frances Avenue

SUMMARY

This staff report is about a matter which Community Council has delegated authority from City Council to make a final decision.

Transportation Services is requesting approval from Etobicoke York Community Council to introduce overnight on-street permit parking on Frances Avenue, between Waniska Avenue and Ringley Avenue, on a street name basis, under the operating hours of 12:01 a.m. to 7:00 a.m., seven days a week.

Area residents requested the implementation of overnight on-street permit parking on Frances Avenue, between Waniska Avenue and Ringley Avenue to accommodate their long term parking needs without being subject to tagging by Parking Enforcement Officers.

RECOMMENDATIONS

The Manager, Permits and Enforcement, Parking, Transportation Services recommends that:

1. Etobicoke York Community Council approve the amendment of Schedule A of City of Toronto Municipal Code, Chapter 925, Permit Parking, to incorporate both sides of Frances Avenue, between Waniska Avenue and Ringley Avenue, on a street name basis, under the operating hours of 12:01 a.m. to 7:00 a.m., seven days a week.

FINANCIAL IMPACT

The amount of \$400.00 is available within the Transportation Services 2019 Operating Budget.

DECISION HISTORY

A request was received from Councillor Mark Grimes, on behalf of area residents, to introduce the overnight on-street permit parking program on Frances Avenue, to accommodate their long term parking needs.

COMMENTS

Frances Avenue, between Waniska Avenue and Ringley Avenue, is a local roadway operating in a two-way north/southbound direction with a pavement width of 6.8 metres. There is no TTC service on Frances Avenue.

Parking is permitted for a maximum 3-hour duration on the both sides of the street.

Under the provisions of Municipal Code, Chapter 925, Permit Parking, we are required to conduct a poll of the residents to determine if there is support to introduce permit parking.

Ballots were mailed on January 29, 2019, with the last day for filing a response being February 27, 2019. The results of the poll are as follows:

The majority of area residents returned their ballots in favour of the introduction of overnight on-street permit parking on Frances Avenue, between Waniska Avenue and Ringley Avenue.

Transportation Services has no objections to the implementation of permit parking on Frances Avenue, between Waniska Avenue and Ringley Avenue.
