

Parking Regulation Amendment - Queen's Drive, between Jane Street and Upwood Avenue

SUMMARY

This staff report is about a matter that Community Council has delegated authority from City Council to make a final decision.

The purpose of this report is to rescind the existing parking prohibition in effect at all times on the north side of Queen's Drive, between Jane Street and Upwood Avenue. The proposed removal is based on a request received from the Ward Councillor after missing signage was installed and area residents expressed their desire to have on-street parking for the City-wide three hour maximum as they did before the missing signage was replaced.

RECOMMENDATIONS

The Acting Director, Traffic Management, Transportation Services, recommends that:

1. Etobicoke York Community Council rescind the existing parking prohibition in effect at all times on the north side of Queen's Drive, between Jane Street and Upwood Avenue.

FINANCIAL IMPACT

The financial cost of removing the "No Parking" signs on Queen's Drive is approximately \$ 200.00. Funding for the removal of the signs is available in the Transportation Services 2019 Operating Budget.

DECISION HISTORY

This report addresses a new initiative.

COMMENTS

Transportation Services replaced missing "No Parking Anytime" signs on the north side of Queen's Drive, between Jane Street and Upwood Avenue. After the signs were installed, the Ward Councillor, on behalf of area residents, requested that the parking prohibition be rescinded to allow on-street parking up to the City-wide maximum of three hours, as the residents and their visitors had been parking on street when the signs were missing. A map of the area is shown on Attachment 1.

Queen's Drive, between Jane Street and Upwood Avenue, is a two-lane local road located within the community east of Jane Street and south of Highway 401. Sidewalks exist on both sides of the road. Currently, parking is prohibited at all times on both sides of Queen's Drive, between Jane Street and Upwood Avenue.

To facilitate parking on the north side of Queen's Drive, between Jane Street and Upwood Avenue, the parking prohibition that is in effect at all times needs to be rescinded. The Ward Councillor supports this recommendation.
