

Installation of On-Street Accessible Parking Spaces - EYD - September 2019 (Delegated)

SUMMARY

This staff report concerns a matter for which Community Council has delegated authority from City Council to make a final decision. The purpose is to obtain approval for the installation of a number of on-street accessible parking spaces.

RECOMMENDATIONS

The Acting Director, Traffic Management, Transportation Services, recommends that:

1. Etobicoke York Community Council authorize the installation of on-street accessible parking spaces at the locations identified in Appendix A attached to the report dated September 19, 2019 from the Acting Director, Traffic Management, Transportation Services.

FINANCIAL IMPACT

Funds in the amount of \$600.00 are available within the Transportation Services Division's 2019 Operating Budget.

DECISION HISTORY

This report addresses an ongoing initiative.

The Transportation Services Division receives a number of requests for the installation of on-street accessible parking spaces for persons with disabilities. Some of these requests come directly from members of the public and others are received through the local Councillors' offices.

The installation of designated on-street accessible parking spaces is a convenience provided for people with disabilities and/or those who transport them, making it easier

for them to find available parking as near as possible to their places of residence or intended destinations and reducing the distances that the disabled people must walk. Delays in installing these on-street accessible spaces may create hardships for disabled applicants.

COMMENTS

Transportation Services staff have investigated the feasibility of installing on-street accessible parking spaces at the locations identified in Appendix A included in this report. None of these sections of roadway are served by TTC transit routes.

For locations where on-street accessible parking spaces are being established, all applicants are holders of valid Accessible Parking Permits issued by the Ministry of Transportation and each designated space will not result in the loss of more than one on-street parking space for general use.

Appendix A

On-street accessible parking spaces to be installed:

Ward	Location
5	Lapp Street, east side, between a point 86.8 metres south of Northland Avenue and a point 5.5 metres further south, from the 1st day of each month to the 15th day of each month from April 1 to November 30, inclusive
5	Lapp Street, west side, between a point 82.5 metres south of Northland Avenue and a point 5.5 metres further south, from December 1 of one year to March 31 of the next following year, inclusive, and from the 16th day of each month to the last day of each month from April 1 to November 30, inclusive
