

Parking Regulation Amendment – Jopling Avenue North between Bloor Street West and Mervyn Avenue

SUMMARY

This staff report is about a matter that Community Council has delegated authority from City Council to make a final decision.

The purpose of this report is to prohibit parking at all times on both sides of Jopling Avenue North, between Bloor Street West and Mervyn Avenue. The proposed prohibition is a result of consultation between staff and the Ward Councillor, to address concerns regarding long term parking on the street by non-residents.

RECOMMENDATIONS

The Acting Director, Traffic Management, Transportation Services recommends that:

1. Etobicoke York Community Council prohibit parking at all times on both sides of Jopling Avenue North, between Bloor Street West and Mervyn Avenue.

FINANCIAL IMPACT

The cost of installing the "No Parking Anytime" signs on Jopling Avenue North is approximately \$ 1,600.00. The funding for these signs is available in the Transportation Services Division's 2019 Operating Budget.

DECISION HISTORY

This report addresses a new initiative.

COMMENTS

Transportation Services received a request from the Ward Councillor to prohibit parking at all times on both sides of Jopling Avenue North, between Bloor Street West and Mervyn Avenue due to concerns with excessive long term parking by non-residents of the street. A map of the area is shown on Attachment 1.

Jopling Avenue North is an 8.5 metre wide two-lane roadway classified in the City of Toronto's Road Classification System as a "local" road. The legal speed limit is 50 km/h and parking in the subject area is currently allowed for a maximum period of three hours on both sides of the street, based on the unsigned three-hour parking by-law. Jopling Avenue North has an urban cross-section (curb and gutter) with no sidewalks on either side of the street

In consultation with the local Councillor, Transportation Services recommends prohibiting parking at all times on both sides of Jopling Avenue North, between Bloor Street West and Mervyn Avenue. This will address concerns regarding long term parking in the area.
