

Parking Regulation Amendment – McCulloch Avenue

SUMMARY

This staff report is about a matter that Community Council has delegated authority from City Council to make a final decision.

The purpose of this report is to recommend that parking be prohibited at all times on the north leg of McCulloch Avenue between Daybar Avenue and the south end of the north leg of McCulloch Avenue. The proposed parking prohibition was requested by an area property owner, in consultation with staff and the Ward Councillor, to address concerns regarding congestion and long-term parking within the subject area.

RECOMMENDATIONS

The Acting Director, Traffic Management, Transportation Services recommends that:

1. Etobicoke York Community Council prohibit parking at all times on both sides of McCulloch Avenue (north leg), between Daybar Avenue and the south end of the north leg of McCulloch Avenue (north leg).

FINANCIAL IMPACT

The cost of installing the "No Parking Anytime" signs on McCulloch Avenue is approximately \$ 1,000.00. The funding for these signs is available in the Transportation Services Division's 2019 Operating Budget.

DECISION HISTORY

This report addresses a new initiative.

COMMENTS

Transportation Services received a request from a property owner on Daybar Avenue that parking be prohibited at all times on both sides of McCulloch Avenue (north leg), between Daybar Avenue and the south end of McCulloch Avenue (north leg). This request is due to concerns with excessive long-term parking and because vehicles parked on both sides of the street often make it difficult for motorists to negotiate a left turn out of the property owner's private driveway. A map of the area is shown on Attachment 1.

McCulloch Avenue is a 7.3 metre wide two-lane roadway classified in the City of Toronto's Road Classification System as a "local" road. The legal speed limit is 50 km/h and parking in the subject area is currently allowed for a maximum period of three hours on both sides of the street, based on the unsigned statutory three-hour parking regulation. McCulloch Avenue has a rural cross-section (ditches and gutter) with no sidewalks on either side of the street.

In consultation with the local Councillor, Transportation Services recommends prohibiting parking at all times on both sides of McCulloch Avenue (north leg), between Daybar Avenue and south end of McCulloch Avenue (north leg). This will address concerns regarding long-term parking and congestion in the area.
