

Introduction of Overnight On-Street Permit Parking – Sundel Avenue, between Cameron Avenue and Venn Crescent

SUMMARY

This staff report is about a matter which Community Council has delegated authority from City Council to make a final decision.

Transportation Services is requesting approval from Etobicoke York Community Council to introduce overnight on-street permit parking on Sundel Avenue, between Cameron Avenue and Venn Crescent, on a street name basis, under the operating hours of 12:00 midnight to 6:00 a.m., 7 days a week.

Residents requested the implementation of overnight on-street permit parking on Sundel Avenue to accommodate their long-term parking needs without being subject to tagging by Parking Enforcement Officers.

RECOMMENDATION

The Manager, Permits and Enforcement, Infrastructure & Development Services, Transportation Services, recommends that:

1. Etobicoke York Community Council approve the amendment of Schedule A of City of Toronto Municipal Code, Chapter 925, Permit Parking, to incorporate the west side of Sundel Avenue, between Cameron Avenue, Venn Crescent, on a street name basis, under the operating hours of 12:00 midnight to 6:00 a.m., 7 days a week.

FINANCIAL IMPACT

The amount of \$400 is available within the Transportation Services 2019 Operating Budget.

DECISION HISTORY

A request was received from Councillor Frances Nunziata, on behalf of area residents, to introduce the overnight on-street permit parking program on Sundel Avenue, between Cameron Avenue and Venn Crescent to accommodate their long-term parking needs.

COMMENTS

Sundel Avenue, between Cameron Avenue and Venn Crescent, is a local roadway operating in a two-way north/southbound direction with a pavement width of 7.30 metres. There is no TTC service provided on Sundel Avenue.

Parking is permitted for a maximum 3-hour duration on the west side at all times. Parking is prohibited on the east side at all times on Sundel Avenue, between Cameron Avenue and Venn Crescent.

Under the provisions of Municipal Code, Chapter 925, Permit Parking, we are required to conduct a poll of the residents to determine if there is support to introduce permit parking.

Ballots were mailed on September 9, 2019, with the last day for filing a response being October 8, 2019. The results of the poll are as follows:

The majority of area residents who returned their ballots are in favour of the introduction of overnight on-street permit parking on Sundel Avenue, between Cameron Avenue and Venn Crescent.

Transportation Services has no objections to the implementation of permit parking on Sundel Avenue.

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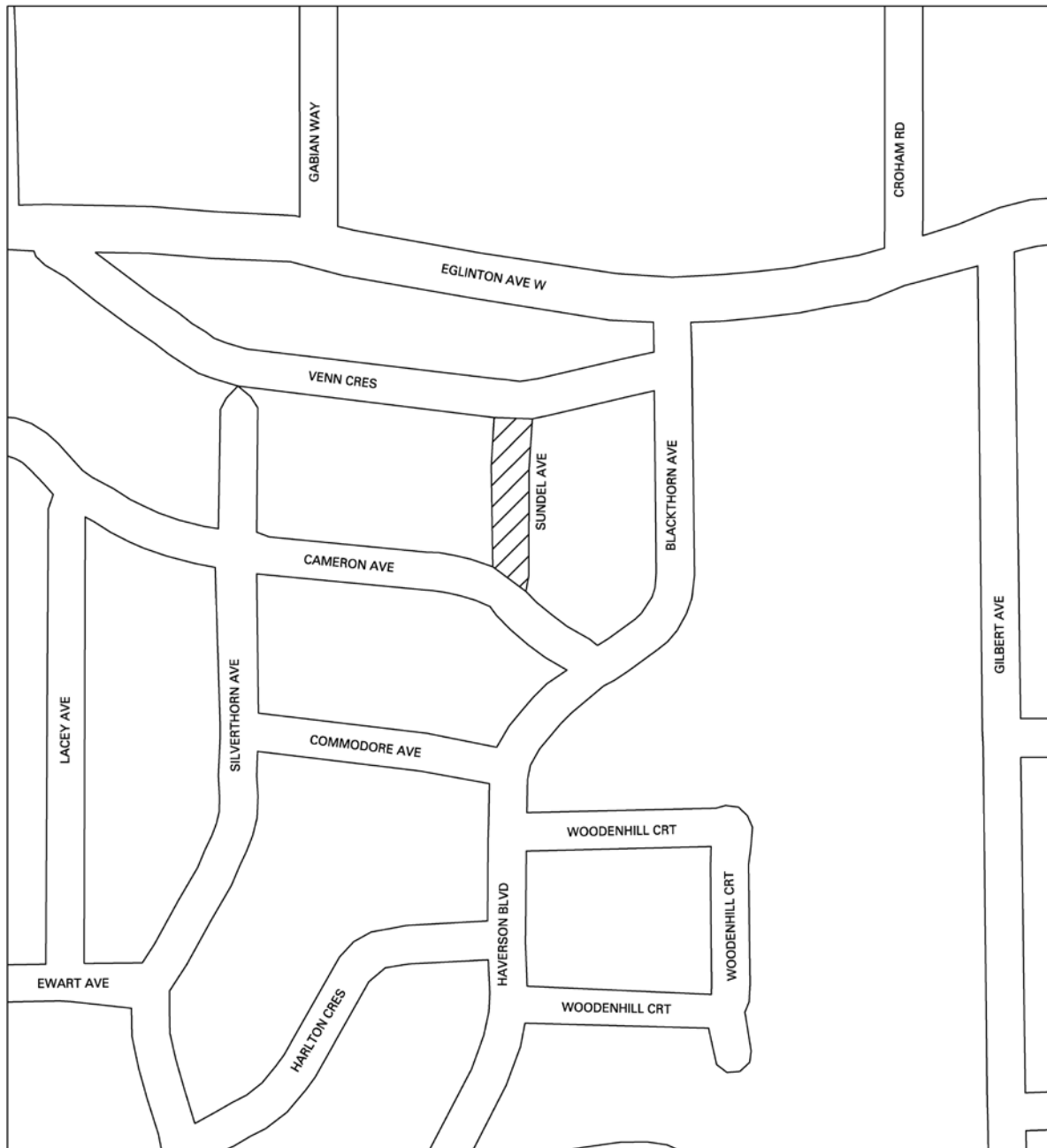
