

Parking Regulation Amendment – King Street, between Weston Road and George Street

SUMMARY

This staff report is about a matter that Community Council has delegated authority from City Council to make a final decision.

The purpose of this report is to obtain approval to amend the existing stopping prohibition in effect from 8:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m. Monday to Friday on the south side of King Street, between Weston Road and George Street to allow the Weston Area Emergency Food Bank, located at 1 King Street, to receive deliveries from 9:30 a.m. to 11:30 a.m. Monday to Friday.

RECOMMENDATIONS

The Acting Director, Traffic Management, Transportation Services, recommends that:

1. Etobicoke York Community Council prohibit parking from 9:30 a.m. to 11:30 a.m., Monday to Friday on the south side of King Street, between a point 32.5 metres east of Weston Road and a point 14 metres further east.
2. Etobicoke York Community Council amend the existing stopping prohibition in effect from 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., Monday to Friday on the south side of King Street, between a point 32.5 metres east of Weston Road and a point 14 metres further east, to be in effect from 8:00 a.m. to 9:30 a.m. and from 11:30 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., Monday to Friday.

FINANCIAL IMPACT

The estimated cost of amending the existing signs is approximately \$ 500.00. The funding for these signs is available in the Transportation Services 2019 Operating Budget.

DECISION HISTORY

This report addresses a new initiative.

COMMENTS

Transportation Services staff received a request from the Ward Councillor, on behalf of the Weston Area Emergency Food Bank located at 1 King Street, to investigate the feasibility of allowing access for delivery to their property. A map of the area is shown on Attachment 1.

King Street is an 8.5-metre wide two-lane road and is classified in the City's Road Classification System as a "local" road. Continuous sidewalks are located on both sides of the street. The parking regulations are as follows:

South Side

- No Stopping 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., Monday to Friday, between Weston Road and George Street.

North Side

- No Standing 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., Monday to Friday, between Weston Road and George Street.

The Weston Area Emergency Food Bank has recently moved into the property located at 1 King Street. There has been difficulty delivering to the facility due to the current stopping prohibition, in effect from 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., Monday to Friday. Prohibiting parking from 9:30 a.m. to 11:30 a.m., Monday to Friday, on the south side of King Street, between a point 32.5 metres east of Weston Road and a point 14 metres further east, will allow delivery trucks to park while actively engaged in loading and unloading of goods at the front of 1 King Street.
