

Parking Regulation Amendment – Lovilla Boulevard

SUMMARY

This staff report is about a matter that Community Council has delegated authority from City Council to make a final decision.

The purpose of this report is to prohibit parking at all times on the north side of Lovilla Boulevard, from a point 114.7 metres west of Strathburn Boulevard to a point 134.3 metres further west. The proposed prohibition was requested by an area resident, in consultation with staff and the Ward Councillor, to address concerns regarding excessive and long-term parking and congestion in the area.

RECOMMENDATIONS

The Acting Director, Traffic Management, Transportation Services recommends that:

1. Etobicoke York Community Council prohibit parking at all times on the north side of Lovilla Boulevard, between a point 114.7 metres west of Strathburn Boulevard and a point 134.3 metres further west.

FINANCIAL IMPACT

The cost of installing the "No Parking Anytime" signs on Lovilla Boulevard is approximately \$ 1000.00. The funding for these signs is available in the Transportation Services Division's 2019 Operating Budget.

DECISION HISTORY

This report addresses a new initiative.

COMMENTS

Transportation Services received a request via the Ward Councillor, on behalf of an area resident, that parking be prohibited at all times on a section of Lovilla Boulevard, west of Strathburn Boulevard. The request is a result of concerns with excessive long-term parking and with vehicles parked on both sides of the street making it difficult for motorists to negotiate the roadway. A map of the area is shown on Attachment 1.

Lovilla Boulevard, in the subject area, has a road width of 8.5 metres and is a two-lane roadway classified in the City of Toronto's Road Classification System as a "local" road. The legal speed limit is 40 km/h. Lovilla Boulevard has an urban cross-section (curb and gutter) with no sidewalks.

Parking is currently allowed at all times for a maximum period of three hours on the south side of the street, based on the unsigned maximum three-hour parking by-law.

Currently, stopping is prohibited from 8:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m., Monday to Friday on the north side of Lovilla Boulevard, from a point 106.8 metres west of Strathburn Boulevard to a point 236.4 metres west of Strathburn Boulevard.

In consultation with the Ward Councillor, Transportation Services recommends prohibiting parking at all times on the north side of Lovilla Boulevard, between a point 114.7 metres west of Strathburn Boulevard and a point 134.3 metres further west. This will address the concerns regarding long-term parking and congestion in the area.
