



The Incumbent Bias


- Creates challenges for those seeking office

2010 Election







Number Of Races Won Since 2003



Conclusion:

RECOMMENDATIONS

The Special Committee on Governance request the City Manager to report back to the committee by the first quarter of 2020 on opportunities and next steps to implement term limits for City Councillors and the Mayor, such report to include but not be limited to:

a survey and analysis on the use of term limits in comparable North American jurisdictions;

b. consideration for the potential impacts of term limits on levels of political engagement, public participation in government, and diversity among elected officials;

c. an extensive public consultation process with residents on their opinions toward term limits;

d. recommended length and number of terms, and transition provisions for term limits; and

e. the required legislative changes to the City of Toronto Act, 2006 and the Municipal Elections Act, 1996 to implement term limits based on the findings in Parts a to d above.
