Summary of the proposed amendments to the Cannabis Regulations under the Cannabis Act, 2017

¹ Delta-9-tetrahydrocannabinol (THC) is the main psychoactive ingredient in cannabis.

² The total amount of THC in a package would be capped at 1,000 mg (e.g. 100 X 10 mg capsules).

³ For example, a package could contain one discrete unit of edible cannabis that contains 10 milligrams of THC; or two discrete units that each contain 5 milligrams of THC.

⁴ This provision is in the Cannabis Regulations in place.
