Residents and visitors may purchase residential and temporary on-street parking permits online. Should non-permit holders be made exempt from parking tickets, parking permit holders may be displaced to other streets or to no parking areas which may cause additional challenges for parking enforcement.

Between 10pm on December 31, 2018 and 10am on January 1, 2019, there were approximately 400 parking tags issued at a value of up to \$18,000. Providing a grace period during these hours would result in an annual revenue loss of approximately \$18,000 to the Parking Tags Enforcement & Operations Operating Budget.
