Report on eliminating single-use plastic in all City of Toronto facilities - by Councillor Mike Colle, seconded by Councillor Jennifer McKelvie

Recommendations

Councillor Mike Colle, seconded by Councillor Jennifer McKelvie, recommends that:

1. City Council request the City Manager, in consultation with the appropriate staff, to report to City Council on a comprehensive plan to reduce or eliminate single-use plastic products in all City of Toronto Facilities where feasible and practical, and to include in the report an outline of other options, including reusable and alternative products that may be deployed to replace single-use plastic products.

The purpose of this Motion is to have the City of Toronto take a leadership role in eliminating single-use plastic waste in all City of Toronto facilities.
