Amendment to the Terms of Reference for the Film, Television and Digital Media Board - by Councillor Paula Fletcher, seconded by Councillor Ana Bailão

#### Recommendations

Councillor Paula Fletcher, seconded by Councillor Ana Bailão, recommends that:

- 1. City Council amend the Terms of Reference for the Film, Television and Digital Media Board by adding Motion Picture Association Canada as a stakeholder representative on the Board, under the same terms and conditions that apply to the other stakeholder representatives.
- 2. City Council appoint Wendy Noss to the Film, Television and Digital Media Board at pleasure of Council as Motion Picture Association Canada's representative, for a term of office ending on November 14, 2022.

## Summary

City Council at its meeting held on March 27 and 28, 2019 established the Film, Television and Digital Media Board for the 2018-2022 Term.

Under the Board's Terms of Reference, the Board is composed of 25 members, including three Members of City Council, a representative of Film Ontario, a representative of the Computer Animation Studios of Ontario and 20 members of the public.

By adding the Motion Picture Association – Canada as a stakeholder on the Board, vital producer and distributor clients will be appropriately represented.
