

Parking Amendments - Rosewell Avenue

SUMMARY

This staff report is about a matter for which Community Council has delegated authority to make a final decision, provided that it is not amended so that it varies with City policy or by-laws.

Transportation Services is requesting North York Community Council to amend the parking regulations on both sides of Rosewell Avenue, between Lawrence Avenue West and Cheritan Avenue, to limit parking to a maximum period of one-hour from 7:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m., Monday to Friday.

The proposed one hour parking limit will address residents' concerns with non-residents parking all day. This activity limits parking availability for residents of Rosewell Avenue. Local residents with a parking permit will be exempt from the one-hour parking limit.

RECOMMENDATIONS

The Acting Director, Traffic Management, Transportation Services, recommends that North York Community Council:

1. Authorize parking for a maximum period of one hour, from 7:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m., Monday to Friday, on the west side of Rosewell Avenue, between Lawrence Avenue West and a point 106 metres north of Cheritan Avenue.
2. Authorize parking for a maximum period of one hour, from 7:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m., Monday to Friday, on the east side of Rosewell Avenue, between Lawrence Avenue West and a point 56 metres south.
3. Authorize parking for a maximum period of one hour, from 7:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m., Monday to Friday, on the east side of Rosewell Avenue, between a point 92 metres south of Lawrence Avenue West and a point 37 metres further south.

4. Authorize parking for a maximum period of one hour, from 7:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m., Monday to Friday, on the east side of Rosewell Avenue, between a point 146 metres south of Lawrence Avenue West and a point 36 metres north of Cheritan Avenue.

FINANCIAL IMPACT

All costs associated with the installation of the parking signs are included within the Transportation Services 2019 Operating Budget.

DECISION HISTORY

This report addresses a new initiative.

COMMENTS

Transportation Services was requested by Councillor Mike Colle, on behalf of area residents, to limit parking to one-hour during the day, Monday to Friday, on both sides of Rosewell Avenue, between Lawrence Avenue West and Cheritan Avenue. This is in order to address residents' concerns with staff of Havergal College Junior School and TTC commuters parking all day. This activity limits parking availability for residents of Rosewell Avenue.

Rosewell Avenue, between Lawrence Avenue West and Cheritan Avenue, is a 12.5 metre wide, two-way local street with a posted 30 km/h speed limit. There is a sidewalk provided on the east side of the street. There is no TTC service provided on Rosewell Avenue.

The Havergal College Junior School property occupies the west side of the subject section of Rosewell Avenue. There are midrise condominiums on the east side of the street. This section of Rosewell Avenue is designated a community safety zone.

Generally, parking is allowed for up to three hours (unsigned) during the day and by permit only from 12:01 a.m. to 7:00 a.m. daily, on both sides of Rosewell Avenue, between Lawrence Avenue West and Cheritan Avenue. There are specific exceptions as follows:

East side

- No parking anytime, 56 metres south of Lawrence Avenue West to 36 metres further south;
- 10 minute parking limit, all times, 129 metres south of Lawrence Avenue West to 36 metres further south;

- Accessible loading zone (No Standing), 30 metres north of Cheritan Avenue and 6 metres further north; and
- No stopping anytime, Cheritan Avenue and 30 metres north.

West side

- No stopping anytime, Cheritan Avenue to 30 metres north; and
- No parking, 8:30 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., 30 metres north of Cheritan Avenue to 76 metres further north.

Transportation Services supports changing the existing three hour parking on both sides of Rosewell Avenue, between Lawrence Avenue West and Cheritan Avenue to one hour parking, from 7:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m., Monday to Friday. This will address resident's concerns with long term parking by non-residents. Local residents with a parking permit will be exempt from the one-hour parking limit. Note that these changes will impact guests, visitors and tradespeople wishing to park on this street.

The Ward Councillor is aware of the recommendations of this staff report.
