

Stopping Prohibitions - L'Amoreaux Drive

SUMMARY

This staff report is about a matter for which the Community Council has delegated authority from City Council to make a final decision.

This report recommends revision to existing parking and stopping prohibitions to relocate them on the south side of L'Amoreaux Drive. These changes are recommended to keep the driveway entrances to the townhomes complexes on the south side of L'Amoreaux Drive clear of parked vehicles to improve sight lines.

RECOMMENDATIONS

The Acting Director, Traffic Management, Transportation Services recommends that:

1. Scarborough Community Council rescind the existing parking prohibition in effect from 2:00 a.m. to 6:00 a.m. and from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. daily on the south side of L'Amoreaux Drive, between Birchmount Road and a point 112 metres west, between a point 252 metres west of Birchmount Road and a point 30 metres further west, and between a point 338 metres west of Birchmount Road and a point 29 metres further west.
2. Scarborough Community Council rescind the existing parking prohibition in effect at all times on the south side of L'Amoreaux Drive, between a point 66 metres west of Birchmount Road and a point 46 metres further west.
3. Scarborough Community Council prohibit stopping at all times on the south side of L'Amoreaux Drive, between a point 66 metres west of Birchmount Road and a point 46 metres further west, between a point 252 metres west of Birchmount Road and a point 30 metres further west, and between a point 338 metres west of Birchmount Road and a point 29 metres further west.

FINANCIAL IMPACT

The financial cost of installing the recommended parking prohibition signs is approximately \$4,000.00. The funding for the signs is available in the Transportation Services Division's Interim Operating Budget.

DECISION HISTORY

This report addresses a new initiative.

COMMENTS

As a result of a request from Councillor Jim Karygiannis, staff reviewed a concern from local residents about vehicles with accessible parking permits that are parking too close to the driveway entrances to the townhome complexes located on south side of L'Amoreaux Drive causing poor sight lines. Transportation Services staff reviewed the parking operation along this portion of the street and have determined that No Stopping Anytime prohibitions are required to prevent vehicles from stopping in the vicinity of the subject driveways.

Existing Conditions

- L'Amoreaux Drive is a two-way collector road between Bridletowne Circle and Birchmount Road.
- L'Amoreaux Drive is a two-lane collector road that runs east to west with a regulatory speed limit of 50 km/h.
- There are municipal sidewalks along both sides of L'Amoreaux Drive. There is no TTC service on L'Amoreaux Drive.
- The land uses on the subject roadway consist mainly of single family residential homes and townhome complexes.

Analysis

Transportation services recommends that the stopping prohibitions be implemented on the subject roadway to discourage motorists from parking and blocking driveways and to prevent from vehicles stopping in the vicinity of the driveways. This will improve sight lines to provide safe access and egress to and from the residential driveways.
