

Stopping Prohibitions – Pachino Boulevard

SUMMARY

This staff report is about a matter for which the Community Council has delegated authority from City Council to make a final decision.

This report recommends the installation of no stopping prohibitions for a restricted period of time and days on both sides of Pachino Boulevard in the vicinity of Terraview-Willowfield P.S. driveway. Currently, there is a default three hour parking on both sides of Pachino Boulevard.

RECOMMENDATIONS

The Acting Director, Traffic Management, Transportation Services, recommends that:

1. Scarborough Community Council prohibit stopping from 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m., Monday to Friday, except public holidays, from September 1 of one year to June 30 of the next following year, inclusive, on both sides of Pachino Boulevard, between Crosland Drive and the east end of Pachino Boulevard.

FINANCIAL IMPACT

The financial cost of installing the above No Stopping signs on Pachino Boulevard is approximately \$1,800.00. The funding for these signs is available in the Transportation Services Division's 2019 interim Operating Budget.

COMMENTS

Further to a request from Councillor Michael Thompson on behalf of an area constituent in regards to concerns of congestion and safety hazards caused by the current parking regulations on Pachino Boulevard, between Crosland Drive to the east end of Pachino Boulevard in the vicinity of Terraview-Willowfield P.S. driveway. Transportation Services staff reviewed the existing parking operations along both sides of Pachino Boulevard and recommend the installation of the no stopping prohibitions for a restricted period of time and days at the subject section of road.

Existing Conditions

- Pachino Boulevard is located south of Hwy 401 and north of Ellesmere Road between Victoria Park Avenue and ends just east of Crosland Drive.
- This section of Pachino Boulevard is a two-way east-west direction local road with a posted speed limit of 40 km/h and is designated as a Community Safety Zone, complete with an All Way Stop Control at Crosland Drive.
- There is municipal sidewalks along the both side for this section of Pachino Boulevard.
- The land use in this neighbourhood consists primarily of single family residential homes and a school zone.

Analysis

Transportation services recommends that the no stopping prohibitions for a restricted period of time and days at the subject section of road to discourage motorists from parking and blocking the two-way flow of traffic entering and exiting the school driveway of school children being picked-up and dropped-off within the school area parking lot. This will improve provide safe access and egress to and from the school and the two residential driveways within this section of road.
